## Our Community Impact 2022: Leprino Foods Company Lemoore East

To support the communities where we live and work, Leprino Foods Company's Lemoore employees and the Leprino Foods Company Foundation (LFCF) annually partner with local nonprofit and other organizations to provide philanthropic donations and volunteer support. Since 2015, the LFCF has contributed nearly \$4,000,000 to the communities where we operate.

Leprino Foods' "Lemoore East" plant, located at 490 F Street, is one of two Leprino Foods locations in the city of Lemoore. During 2022, Lemoore East and the LFCF supported 15 local and regional organizations with donations and grants totaling nearly \$20,000.

Lemoore East employees volunteer their time to help improve livelihoods, foster empowerment, and build resilient communities. Volunteering is employee-driven, and activities support four focus areas of Nutrition, Education, Fitness, and Local Needs. We are proud to be involved with local and regional organizations that celebrate the many diverse cultures, communities and lifestyles that comprise our community like youth, families, homeless and those in recovery.

The Lemoore East Community Impact Team (CIT), made up of passionate employee volunteers, supports the Kings County community in various ways including providing a \$6,000 Leprino Foods Company Foundation grant to Reestablishing Stratford, and donations to the Volunteer Fire Department, City of Hanford Parks & Rec, Lemoore Day Pizza Festival and Hanford Rotary. The plant supported community members in recovery through \$3,000 in donations to Champions Recovery Alternative Programs Inc. In addition, donations supported MIQ Schools and Kings Christian Sober Grad Night.

Nutrition is a key focus area for Leprino Foods and, in 2022, the Lemoore East plant supported nutrition in though financial donations and grants, employee food drives and volunteerism. A \$6,500 Leprino Foods Company Foundation grant was awarded to **Lemoore Christian Aid Inc. Food Pantry.** Longtime partner **God's Breadbox** was supported through a \$7,500 LFCF grant, a \$1,000 donation, and employee volunteerism during the Leprino Foods Company inaugural Month of Impact in September. Employees also volunteered at **West Hills** packing and distributing food in September and hosted a canned food drive.

The Lemoore East plant supported the diary industry through a \$1,500 donation to **California Creamery Operators Association**.

Lemoore East employees are committed to veteran support, including awarding a \$6,000 Leprino Foods Company Foundation grant to the **American Legion**; and a combined total of more than \$1,600 in donations to Hanford's **Nisel Liberty VFW Post, Veterans of Foreign Wars Golf Tournament** and the **14**th **District Legionnaire**.

We are proud of the partnerships we've built and organizations we have been able to support in our community. We look forward to continuing to make a positive impact on our community and the people in it.
